PROPOSAL FOR BEIJING INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

JULY AND AUGUST 4-WEEK PROGRAMS

CONVERSATION PLUS & ACADEMIC ENGLISH PROGRAMS

SUMMER 2008

Program dates: July 7 – August 1, 2008

CONVERSATION PLUS

- 80 total hours of classroom ESL instruction and program activities (during the four weeks)
- Students will enroll in the regular 4-week Conversation Plus English language program, thus integrating them with students from all over the world. Highlights of the Conversation Plus program:
 - 20 hours per week of ESL classes emphasizing fluency-building and vocabulary
 - Lesson include relevant, practical grammar instruction with highly interactive classwork.
 - UCSD students (native speakers) attend class approximately four hours per week for guided conversation and fluency-building practice with the international students.
 - Three field trips and several guest-speaker events are integrated into the language-learning curriculum through carefully planned lessons.
- Moderate homework required.
- Textbooks and instructional materials must be purchased by each student (up to about \$100 USD per student)

ACADEMIC ENGLISH

- 80 total hours of classroom ESL instruction (during the four weeks)
- Weekly curriculum is organized as follows: 10 hours per week of integrated skills core class (with an emphasis on reading and writing); 10 hours per week of electives classes – students choose two electives from a selection of Academic Essays, TOEFL Preparation, Pronunciation & Fluency, American Short Stories, Listening & Notetaking, and others.
- Substantial homework required.
- Textbooks and instructional materials must be purchased by each student (up to about \$150 USD per student)

- Option 1: Homestay accommodation with daily breakfast and dinner (arranged through San Diego Homestay or Foreign Student Homestay of San Diego) – students must purchase all lunches separately and daily during homestay.
Option 2: Shared-bedroom campus apartment accommodation with meals (All on-campus housing includes 3 meals per day in assigned campus cafeterias; the meal plan is not separate from the on-campus housing and must be included.)
- Proof of high-quality medical insurance in English is required OR it must be purchased from UC-San Diego for additional \$140 USD per student.
- San Diego bus pass may be purchased for additional \$25 USD at campus Transportation office
- UCSD Extension photo ID card costs an additional \$15 and permits free, unlimited use of public buses within a 5-mile radius of campus

Note: If the student does not provide proof in English of high-quality portable medical insurance for the duration of the program before arrival, the student must pay \$140 USD for UCSD medical insurance upon arrival. A student without proof on file of medical insurance cannot begin any program activities or classes.

** The homestay fee must be paid directly by the student to the homestay agency upon arrival. Students apply separately to the homestay agency to arrange homestay placement.
